Please fill out this Application Form, SAVE it to your computer, and then email the saved document as an attachment to <a href="ed.o.fund@gmail.com">ed.o.fund@gmail.com</a> to start the application process. The following materials should be compiled into one package or file and either scanned/emailed or mailed as soon as possible, but no later than March 1 to The Educational Opportunities Fund, 145 Brownell Ave., New Bedford, MA 02740. Incomplete applications cannot be considered.

Upon receipt of a complete application, EOF staff will assess the applicant and if possible, secure a camp placement. Once a placement is secured, the applicant will then begin all paperwork directly with the placement (program application, health form and other forms required by the organization).

If you have previously been granted a scholarship please do not assume that it will be granted again; the process begins fresh at the beginning of each enrollment season. We suggest that you explore other/additional funding possibilities while waiting for a decision on the status of your application. The best scenario is when applicants are able to gather support from a variety of sources. Note that scholarships do not cover camp store fees, transportation or equipment.

So that EOF will have material to celebrate the scholarship support we provide, we need your permission to use photos or videos of your child, or their work (ex: art, song or letters) in our publications. When you sign this application, you give EOF permission to use your child's image, work or voice for promotional and educational purposes. You waive any right to inspect or approve the material that may be used for EOF's publication needs. There is no time-limit on the validity of this release nor is there any geographic specification of where these materials may be distributed.

**Sponsor:** If appropriate, applicants are encouraged to identify a sponsor to help them through the application process and the tasks associated with preparing for their summer experience (organizing transportation, acquisition of materials required for the program, and perhaps guidance in anticipation of and during the program).

The following materials are required each year, even if you have previously received a scholarship and are re-applying.

- 1) **Application form** (2<sup>nd</sup> page of this document).
- 2) A letter written by the applicant, addressed to the selection committee of the EOF board, explaining the applicant's motivation for the application; i.e., what does the applicant hope to gain from the experience, what/how does the applicant hope to contribute to the host community, what challenge(s) can the applicant foresee and how will the applicant address/overcome those challenges should they arise (i.e., homesickness).
- 3) A letter written by the applicant's parent or guardian, addressing the same questions as above. Note: The parent, guardian or sponsor is encouraged to talk with the applicant before the letters are written, but the student should write their own letter.
- 4) **All applicable and most recent 1040 tax forms,** including 1040 tax forms from additional guardians outside the primary household.
- 5) **A photograph** of the applicant is appreciated. If applicant is applying for second year, a photo taken during the previous camp program is preferable.
- 6) **A note outlining other sources of funding** being pursued by the applicant and/or family or guardian.
